1: Opening statement from senior management

R and R C Bond (Wholesale) Limited T/A Bond International ("**Bond International**") is committed to preventing acts of modern slavery and human trafficking from occurring within its business and supply chain, and imposes the same high standards on its suppliers.

2: Structure of the organisation

Our business involves the distribution and wholesaling of tyres across the UK. Our supply chain therefore primarily involves the purchase and distribution of tyres. It is complex and global in nature.

3: Policies

As part of our commitment to combating modern slavery, we have implemented an anti bribery policy and a bribery and corruption policy.

4: Due diligence

As part of our efforts to monitor and reduce the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring within our supply chains, we have adopted the following due diligence procedures:

- establish and assess areas of potential risk in our business and supply chains
- monitor potential risk areas in our business and supply chains
- reduce the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring in our business and supply chains
- provide adequate protection for whistle blowers

5: Risk and compliance

We enforce a strict code of compliance and do not tolerate slavery and human trafficking within our supply chains. For example, we have requested that all of our high-risk suppliers provide us with their anti- salary policy. Further, if we find evidence of slavery and human trafficking, we will immediately seek to terminate our relationship with the relevant supplier.

6: Further actions and sign-off

Following our review of our actions this financial year to prevent slavery or human trafficking from occurring in our business or supply chains, we intend to provide further training to our employees and policies are available for guidance in our handbook.

This statement is made in accordance with section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes Bond International slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year commencing 1st January 2019 to 31st December 2019.
